What does the EUROCLIO International Training Course Provide?

- Raised **awareness of cultures and identities** through shared reflection on the teaching of history across Europe

How to Apply for the Erasmus+ Funding?

Erasmus+ is available for all history, citizenship and heritage educators, but **Schools** have to submit their application to their National Agencies. *Individual teachers can not apply!*

1. Contact the [National Agency](#) in your country in order to obtain the application form and instructions on the Erasmus+ program **KA1: Mobility Project through School Education Staff**.
2. Use the provided [EUROCLIO Toolkit](#) with support documents on how to include EUROCLIO Annual Conference 2015 in the Erasmus+ training list of your school.
3. Make sure your schools submit the application **before 17th March 2014**.
