How to Participate in the EUROCLIO International Training Course in Denmark 2015?

We invite you and your school to apply to the Erasmus+ program.

## What does the EUROCLIO International Training Course Provide?

- Access to **innovative history education methods and tools** from across Europe with a focus on education for democratic citizenship.
- Recognition and support for key competences for lifelong learning.
- Raised **awareness of cultures and identities** through shared reflection on the teaching of history across Europe
- Access to **new international partnerships**, including schools, educational authorities and institutes in different fields and sectors.
- Inclusion in Europe's most active Community of History Educators
- Improved English-language competence through facilitated and engaged dialogues

## How to Apply for the Erasmus+ Funding?

Erasmus+ is available for all history, citizenship and heritage educators, but <u>Schools</u> have to submit their application to their National Agencies. *Individual teachers can not apply!* 

- Contact the <u>National Agency</u> in your country in order to obtain the application form and instructions on the Erasmus+ program KA1: Mobility Project through School Education Staff.
- 2. Use the provided <u>EUROCLIO Toolkit</u> with support documents on how to include EUROCLIO Annual Conference 2015 in the Erasmus+ training list of your school.
- 3. Make sure your schools submit the application before 17th March 2014.
